## Requirements for Sale and Consumption of Beer at the Scott County/Forest Coliseum

- 1. Beer Permit (Required 30 days prior to event with contract)
  - A. Cost \$ 5000.00
  - B. Obtained from Coliseum Board President and Coliseum Director
  - C. Insurance certificate for \$1,000,000.00 naming Scott County/Forest Coliseum, City of Forest, Forest Mayor and Board of Aldermen, Scott County Board of Supervisors and Scott County/Forest Coliseum Board as insured. Certificate must include a liquor liability clause.
  - D. Proof of Mississippi ABC licenses and all permits required by state law
- 2. Consumption of Beer allowed in designated areas only. Example: Concerts (Inside Coliseum only), Car Show (Beer Garden)
  - A. Must be 21 years of age to consume beer or be allowed in beer garden.
  - B. Beer can only be sold by the cup or can. (NO glass bottles)
  - C. Only 2 beers can be sold to any one person at any one time.
  - D. All Mississippi laws and City ordinances apply to the sale and consumption.
  - E. Beer garden will be in 1 of 2 predetermined locations. One is located in the upper parking area and one in the lower parking area, the promoter can choose which ONE they would like to use.
- 3. Concessions must be sold by Coliseum with NO outside food vendors.
- 4. Clean-up deposit of \$250.00 (payable with contract) is required and is refundable if grounds are cleaned immediately after the event.
- 5. Security provided at promoters expense
  - A. A minimum of 8 certified officers or licensed security is required for a small event (500 or less in attendance). More than 8 are required for large events (500 and up).
  - B. 50% of security must come from Forest Police Department and/or Scott County Sheriff's Office

- C. Coliseum must know at least a week prior to show who the local security will be.
- D. No beer will be sold unless security is present.

Permit fee and clean-up fee are due with the rent deposit 30 days prior to event with contract.
